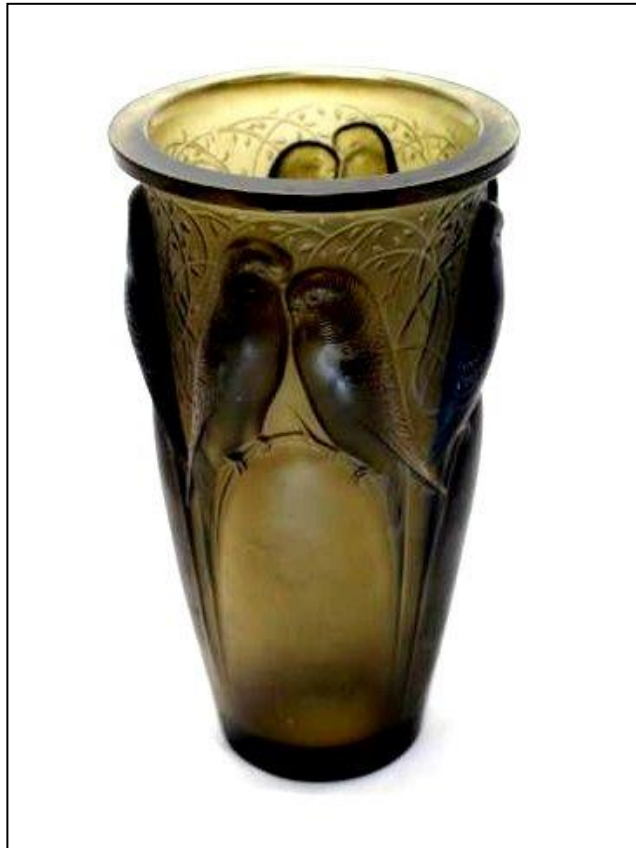


TOPAZ **CEYLAN**

This topaz 'CEYLAN' is very rare. The most commonly found colour is opalescent, which is still an expensive and desirable vase. The clear glass version is less desirable. There is also a yellow amber model, which is also rare, but this is only the second topaz version ever seen or acquired by Burr & Muir.

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
