

## Statuette **GRANDE NUE SOCLE LIERRE**

By Rene Lalique

First executed in 1919

---

A rare *Grande Nue* (large nude) statue, moulded as a young standing maiden with a raised arm whilst holding her hair which trails to her feet, fitted into its original circular rosewood chinoiserie stand (*socle Lierre*). An original umber patina still remains on the figure.

Height : 42 cms

Signatures : Signed wheel-carved *R Lalique* and etched *France* on the glass base.
