

'Large Nude Dancer'

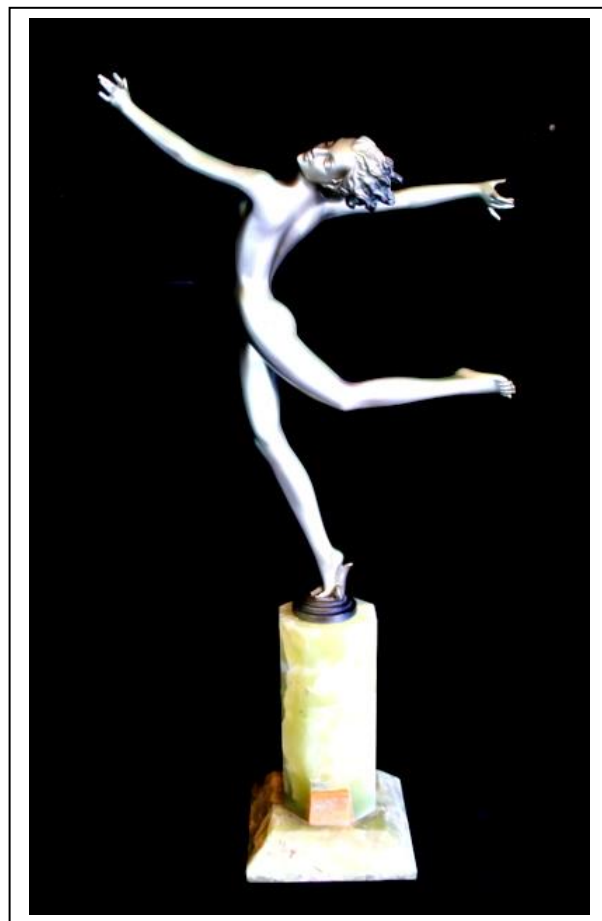

A large silvered and cold painted bronze figurine, modelled as a nude dancer, balancing in her right foot, her left leg raised to the back, and her arms stretched out, one forwards, one backwards. She balances on a large green onyx base.

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Josef Lorenzl worked in Austria, where he designed some of the most theatrical Art Deco sculpture. His figures are always snake-hipped young girls, with long slender bodies, hands and feet.

Lorenzl's works range in size from 12 cm to about 75 cm. This is therefore one of the larger and rarer examples.

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
