

Nude 'Dancer'

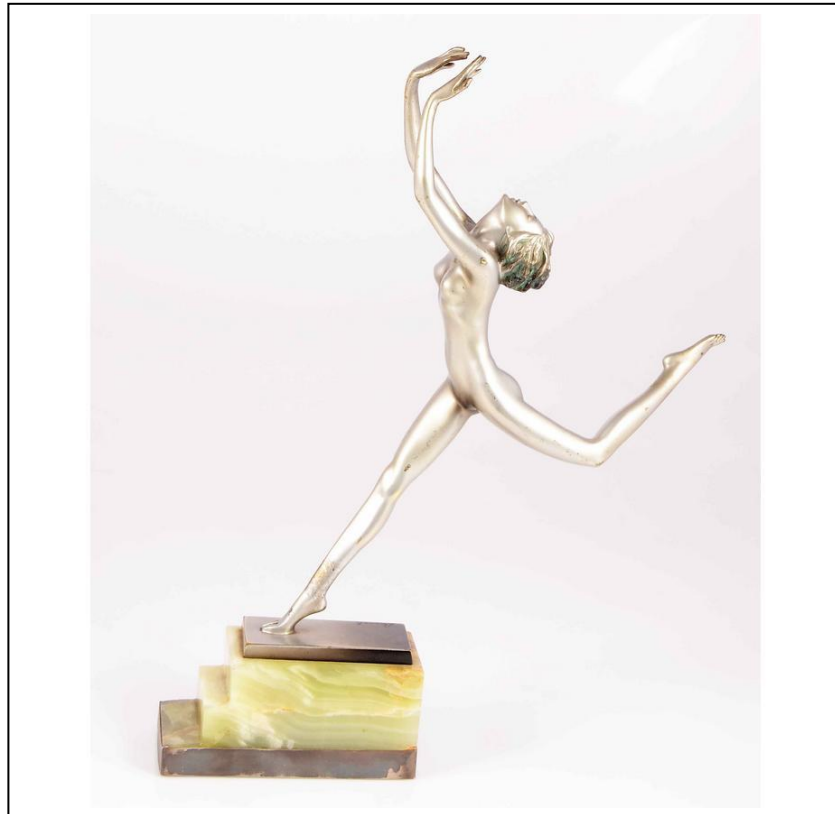

A cold painted bronze figurine, a nude female figure leaping forward, right foot outstretched and touching ground, back leg raised behind her. Her hands together stretching skywards above her. She balances on a green onyx base, the lower tier being covered by a silvered bronze band.

Josef Lorenzl worked in Austria, where he designed some of the most theatrical Art Deco sculpture. His figures are always snake-hipped young girls, with long slender bodies, hands and feet.

Lorenzl's works range in size from 12 cm to about 75 cm.

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
