

Vase **SALMONIDES**

First executed in 1928

An extremely rare large opalescent globular glass vase, the design comprising dense school of entwined salmon covering the entire surface of the vase.

Height : 29 cms

Signatures : Moulded 'R LALIQUE' on base, as well as a script signature and number 1015.

‘SALMONIDES’ is one of Lalique’s largest vases. It was made in clear glass and opalescent glass, the latter being the rarest.

This particular model has strong opalescence, which is a very good feature on an opalescent mould-blown vase. It also has good strong patina remaining on the surface.

Lalique also designed a tiny vase with the same design, but with a different neck, named **‘OLERON’**, and stands just 9 cm high.

It has been many years since we have had the privilege of having an opalescent **‘SALMONIDES’** in stock.
