

RED AMBER **Penthièvre**

By Rene Lalique

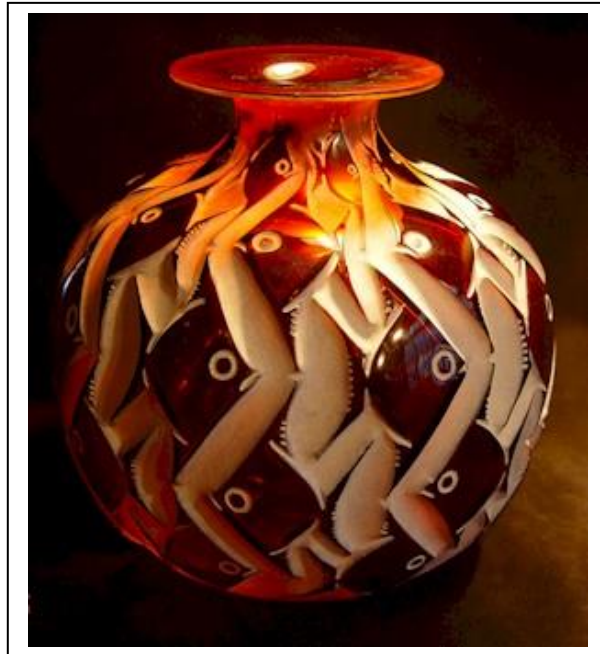
First executed in 1928

A very rare red amber vase with wide everted rim, the round shape decorated with large stylised angelfish in relief, the fish highly polished, the recesses in mat. A white patina sits in the recesses, accentuating the design.

Height : 26 cms

Signatures : Engraved script 'R Lalique' on base, and 'No.1011'.
